

Following is a comprehensive list of radiographs for a purchase exam for Dr. Mark R. Baus and his client. Certain views can be deleted for the sake of economy and after discussion with the buyer or their agent.

- Front limbs [shoes removed]:
 - o 60 degree DP and skyline of each navicular bone
 - o DP of front feet and fetlock [combined] with 10 degree downward angle.
 - Separate lateral views of the front feet [aimed at ground level] and the fetlock.
 - Oblique views of fetlock and pastern [I prefer these views with each foot placed on a 3-4 inch block and a 10 degree downward angle aimed at the mid-pastern region, it will show oblique views of the coffin joint, pastern joint and fetlock joint].
- Hind limbs
 - 4 views of each hock (DP, lateral and obliques)
 - o Lateral, DP and oblique views of hind fetlocks
 - Lateral and caudal-cranial views of each stifle
- Back (if necessary based on findings)
 - o 3-4 views of dorsal spines from the withers to the lumbar region.
